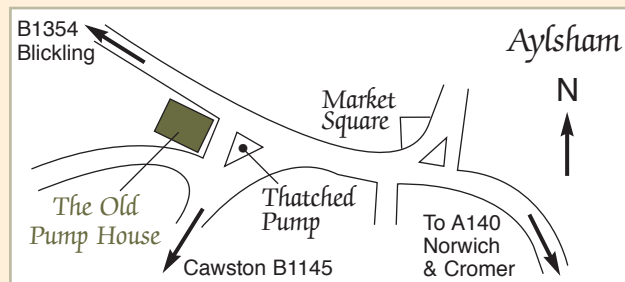

The Old Pump House, built around 1750, still retains its old fashioned charm and character. The house has had a rich and interesting past due to its history as a farm, boarding school and rectory.

The five en suite bedrooms were totally refurbished in 2007 and are tastefully furnished and decorated. All rooms have wireless internet connections, LCDTVs, compact disc alarm clocks, tea and coffee

making facilities and hairdryers. There is private parking for six cars at the front of the house.

Breakfast, featuring the finest local produce, is freshly cooked to order and served in the elegant, pine shuttered Georgian Room, overlooking the pretty, tranquil garden and pond.
